### Wisemans Ferry PS Bushfire Plan

Here is a very basic overview:

In the event of a bushfire, **if we do not have enough notice to evacuate**, the following steps will be taken:

We will 'SHELTER IN'

Principal will ensure all staff, students and on-site visitors remain calm and are sheltered in K Block (4/5/6 room) with our bushfire survival kit

Principal will liaise with emergency services on the school mobile phone

Principal will send a group text to all parents advising of the situation

*(Parents are not to respond to the text as this will stop the phone being used to liaise with emergency services)*

Principal will update parents every 30 minutes (if possible) of the situation

Parents are not to enter the school to collect children unless advised by principal or emergency services

Principal will contact parents when it is safe to collect students or make arrangements for collection.

For the safety of your children, parking is **not** permitted in the school carpark between the hours of 8.30-9.15am and 2.15-3pm. Also, there is no car parking in the bus zone at the front of the school. The safety of your children is extremely important to us.
