What's On at Penrith Observatory in July 2019

Date: Saturday 6 July 2019

Event name: Public Astronomy Night: The Astronomy and Navigation of Aboriginal Australians

Event details:

Speaker – Prof. Ray Norris Aboriginal people in Australia have a rich astronomical tradition such as the "Emu in the Sky" constellation of dark clouds, and stories about the Sun, Moon, and stars, revealing a great depth and complexity of pre-contact Aboriginal cultures. Not only did they know the sky intimately, but they were familiar with planetary motions, tides, and eclipses. Their songs and stories show that Aboriginal Australians sought to understand their Universe in a similar way to modern science. They used this knowledge of the sky to construct calendars, song-lines, and other navigational tools, enabling them to navigate across the country, trading artefacts and sacred stories. Includes presentation, short 3D movie, tour of the dome and viewing of the night sky through a range of telescopes (weather permitting).

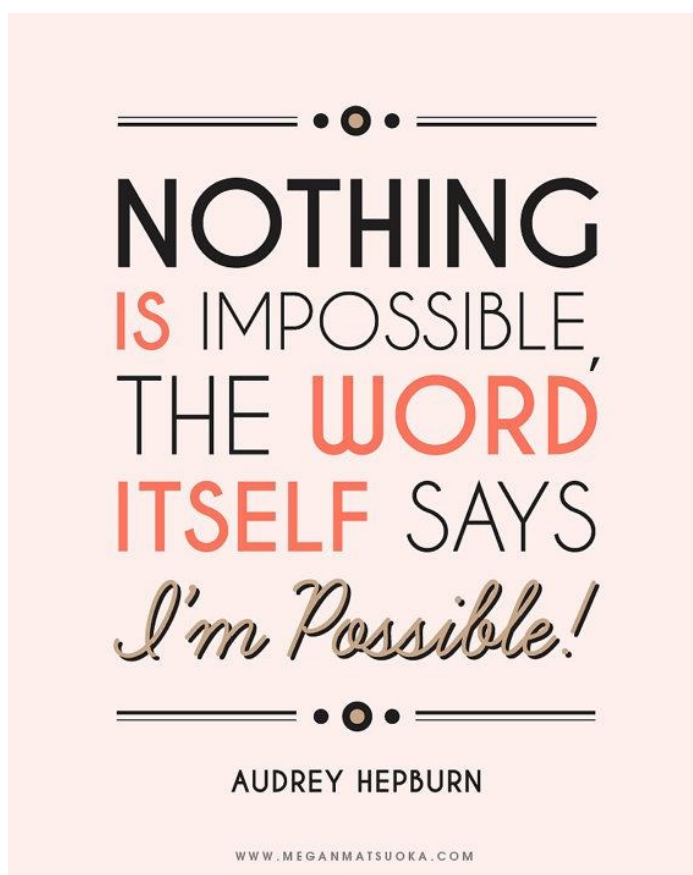
