It is really important all children are at school on time each day. You **must** report to the office with your child to provide an explanation if your child is late to school. Children presenting late without a parent/carer are marked as an unjustified absence. It is a legal requirement that teachers document all student absences in the class roll, regardless of the duration time of the absence. The Home School Liaison Officer, from the Department of Education monitors class rolls and follows up on children whose records show an unusual number of absences, patterns of repeated partial absences and/or unexplained absences.
